



In reference to LightSquared request to affirm its license, I would respectfully like to express my opposition to this request, until LightSquared has proven their system will not interfere with high-precision GPS.

I am a surveyor for Indiana Department of Transportation, and was responsible for the creation of the Indiana Continuously Operating Reference Station (InCORS). This is a statewide GPS network registered with the National Geodetic Survey that can be utilized freely by any user with current GPS equipment. This system is also tied to similar CORS systems in Ohio and Kentucky. While I do not know the exact amount of users, I do know that there are many agencies that utilize this system, such as the Ag industry, State Police, Surveyors to name a few that come to mind. It has been operational for two years with interest and number of users still growing. It would be a shame to go approve the LightSquared request (which ignores the recent independent test results), until they have proven their system will not degrade the accuracy and value that the CORS offers its many users.

In continuing expressions of concerns regarding the attempts to expand the operational characteristics of the LightSquared Subsidiary LLC, while it appears that the efforts to find amicable solutions to the threats represented to the existing uses of the affected radio spectrum will be challenged under compromise, it should be obvious to both beneficiaries and those negatively affected alike that the system if fully implemented will continue to demonstrate the damages to the networking capabilities of a very large sector of the American engineering community.

It will also demonstrate the weaknesses of a system-wide capability of American enterprise that, until being limited and diminished by the actions of a minority interest (that evidently demonstrates an apparent disregard for the established order) was operating under the provisions of governmental protection from unfair competition.

So, the question remains: where were the protections?

It does not appear that appropriate protections were put into place and that such protections should be determined as necessary for maintaining a balance in the market place as well as making a determination those national security interests of the public airwaves is protected as well.
