

Dear Ms. Dortch:

San Diego Gas & Electric Company ("SDG&E" or the "Company") recently advised the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") that the Company has provided certain information to Sirius XM Radio, Inc. ("Sirius XM") regarding Wireless Communications Service ("WCS") facilities the Company has deployed.¹ The purpose of that correspondence was to clarify what Sirius XM now has acknowledged: that SDG&E has made a continued effort to cooperate with Sirius XM² and with the Aerospace and Flight Test Radio Coordinating Council ("AFTRCC") by sharing this information.

The Company has not looked into and expresses no opinion on the applicability of the FCC's information sharing requirements with regard to SDG&E's WCS pilot program as currently deployed.
