

Light Squared LLC's Petition requests approval of their use of certain frequencies that will absolutely and positively disrupt and devastate reliable and accurate Global Positioning Satellite signals as shown by the results of independent recent tests. There are also unquantifiable Military, Law Enforcement, Emergency Services, Meteorological, Geodetic, Oceanic, Outer Space, and other untold applications of the use of the GPS system that would be rendered inaccurate or void.

In summary, it would appear that the present GPS utility that has been developed for the use, peace of mind, and good of all mankind, as we now know it, will cease to exist and result in a severely adverse detrimental effect on the conduct of all Governmental operations, the Free Enterprise System of Business, and the Safety and Security of all Citizens.

It is sincerely and humbly requested that Madame Secretary strongly consider denial of any approval of the subject Petition of Light Squared, LLC.
