On January 10, 2012, the Enforcement Bureau ("Bureau") filed Motion to Extend January 20, 2012 Discovery Deadline.

It appears from the Motion, that the Bureau and party Skytel await a ruling from the Presiding Judge on proposed discovery on Issue (g) of the *HDO*.¹ Because of a pressing matter that took priority,² there has been some delay which soon shall be rectified. Certainly, those two interested parties are entitled to a ruling on their pending discovery requests.


It further appears that the pleading cycle on a petition to intervene filed by Pinnacle Wireless, Inc., alleging possession of relevant information on Issue (g), was completed on January 6, 2012. That request to intervene presently is under active consideration by the Presiding Judge, assisted by a new intern law clerk.

It further appears that under the circumstance of the status of this complicated litigation, the requested relief is reasonable and appropriate.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the Enforcement Bureau's Motion To Extend certain discovery beyond January 20, 2012, IS GRANTED, *Sine Die*.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a Prehearing Conference IS SET for January 25, 2012, at 9:30 a.m., in OALJ's courtroom at the Commission (Rm. TW A-363). Maritime shall present information on the status of its bankruptcy proceeding, and findings of the bankruptcy court, and its views on preparedness for referral to the Wireless Telecommunication Bureau for its consideration of Second Thursday.

¹ Issue (g) concerns issues against Maritime for alleged Nonconstruction and Discontinuance of Site-Based Operations. Those issues are to be litigated in this proceeding notwithstanding Maritime's pending request for Second Thursday relief, and a related petition from Maritime to a bankruptcy court.
