On Tuesday, January 24, 2012, Purple executives, John Goodman and Dan Luis, met with Paul de Sa of the Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis and Nick Alexander.

In that meeting, the parties discussed the FCC’s recently released Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking related to the video relay industry. The discussion included questions related to the practical implementation of either a per user compensation model or a modified per minute compensation model and the associated database for verification and validation purposes.

During the meeting, Purple voiced its support of certain benefits derived from continued consumer choice among service providers and platforms, and protection of dial around options. Purple also reiterated its support of the fNPRM’s objectives of creating a predictable outlook on the industry that encourages continued investment and innovation and market competition and indicated that its full comments will be forthcoming in a future filing on the items included in the fNPRM.
