I am a recreational boater that uses GPS to navigate during periods of inclement weather and normal navigation. If Light Squared were to go into operation I, along with millions of other recreational boaters, would be forced to purchase new GPS equipment if it were available. The only viable path forward for Light Squared is to make the current GPS users whole by Light Squared purchasing new units for each one that is turned in, much the same that the BAS spectrum was handled. This time make Light Squared responsible for payment of the new equipment not the GAO or any other branch of our government. This should not be a hand out for Light Squared.
