Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to the *Third Report and order* in PS Docket No. 08-146, and *Public Notice* DA 08-1866, on September 5, 2008, Nex-Tech Wireless, LLC ("NTW") notified the Commission of its election not to participate in the Commercial Mobile Alert System ("CMAS"). NTW now notifies the FCC of its change in election. The company now elects to fully participate in CMAS.

As required by Section 10.210 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 10.210, NTW agrees to transmit CMAS alerts in a manner consistent with the technical standards, protocols, procedures, and other technical requirements implemented by the Commission. NTW further commits to support the development and deployment of technology for the "C" interface, the CMS provider Gateway, the CMS provider infrastructure, and mobile devices with CMAS functionality and support of the CMS provider selected technology.

NTW reserves the right to change its election at a later date as circumstances warrant, and in accordance with the Commission's rules.
