**PETITION FOR EXEMPTION OF THE CLOSED CAPTIONING
REQUIREMENTS UNDER THE "ECONOMICALLY BURDENSOME"
STANDARDS, 47 C.F.R. § 79.1(f)**

Personally appeared before the undersigned officer, duly authorized to administer oaths in the State of Georgia, ADRIENNE D. PRICE, after having been duly sworn, deposes and makes this her statement and General Affidavit upon oath, affirmation of belief and personal knowledge that the following matters, facts and things set forth are true and correct to the best of her knowledge:

1.

I, ADRIENNE D. PRICE, am the Office Administrator of Unionville Missionary Baptist Church located at 3837 Houston Avenue, Macon, Georgia 31008 in Bibb County and have served in that capacity since 2004. I am over twenty-one (21) years of age and am competent to testify as to the matters set forth herein.

I understand that this Affidavit is being submitted in response to notification that the Federal Communications Commission has reversed the exemption granted to Unionville Missionary Baptist Church based on the premise that the exemption status relied on the Anglers Order's. Accordingly, I authorize the use of this Affidavit for all purposes allowable under the law in response to the dismissal of our exemption status and to serve as a new petition for exemption from the closed captioning requirements for our television broadcast.

The Organization: Unionville Missionary Baptist Church, founded in 1865, is a non-profit, religious organization made up of persons banded together for the purpose of worshipping, witnessing and working for God. It is our mission to develop spiritual leadership, encourage and enhance discipleship and provide a place of fellowship for those who have dedicated and/or wish to dedicate their lives to Christ. The church does this through preaching and teaching from the Books of the Holy Bible as well as through community outreach. Community outreach is accomplished through the work and development of our ministries (clothing, youth advisory, evangelism, nursing), church programs (Vacation Bible School, Black History Productions), community outreach projects (Middle GA Faith Community Katrina Relief, D.A.R.E. Summer Camp, Prodigal Friendship Ministry, R.J. Fambro Scholarship, etc.), the church website and television broadcasts.

4.

The Programming: In order to effectively fulfill our mission, we must be capable of spreading the word of God to the masses. The most proficient method of doing so is through television broadcasting. Through the years, our church services are transmitted to those who are not physically able to attend worship services and church functions. The homebound are then enabled by receiving the word of God as though they were in the midst of those who are in attendance in the sanctuary. Our church service is broadcast twice over five different channels (See attached program - Exhibit 1). Program distribution over these channels is handled through 41 NBC – WMGT and has the potential of reaching 250,000 households in Middle Georgia with Cox Communications. It is also broadcast four times on two additional channels which are not indicated on the exhibit as they serve Forsyth, Georgia (Channel 25) and Covington, Georgia (Channel 17) which are outside of Bibb County where most of our parishioners reside. The program is not distributed nationally and the church does not profit financially from the distribution of the program.

Expense of Closed Captioning Service Information: In 2006, account representative Greg Oliver of 41 NBC-WMGT indicated that after the church provides the recording on DVD, the cost for roll-up captions which would include transcription

services, captioning, DVD authoring and disc stock would be \$ 10.00 per minute for each 30 minute broadcast (\$300 per broadcast). As a result, the cost to continue to broadcast our services twice over five different channels would be \$ 3,000.00 per week and roughly \$ 156,000.00 annually. The station was unable to provide any assistance to alleviate the cost. Today, Marketing Consultant Selina Carr, was unable to provide information relevant to providing this service for our programming as they currently make it available for news programming. In addition, the station has a new General Manager who has not had an opportunity to assess all factors in providing this service to our program. It is her hope that the information will be available in a few days (Exhibit 2). This additional information will be submitted to the FCC upon receipt. Caption Labs of Media Images.Com considered our non-profit status and provided a quote with a reduced rate of \$ 165.00 per episode which amounts to \$ 1,650.00 per week and roughly \$ 85,800.00 annually. Their regular rate is \$ 237.00 (Exhibit 3). Although Caption Labs reduced the rate of providing the closed captioning service, the church is unable to absorb the additional expense.

The church could opt to purchase equipment to provide closed captioning services during recording; however, a complete captioning system for our current operation would cost at a minimum \$ 8,000.00 as the cost of equipment and supplies is variable. We are in need of a closed caption encoder (ranging from \$ 2, 924.95 to \$ 10,806.50), transcription equipment (ranging from \$ 150.00 to \$775.00), Betacam or DigiBeta Tape (ranging from \$9.50 to \$200.00), adapter cords, software etc. Although these would not be recurring expenses, the cost of maintaining such equipment would be (Exhibit 4a, 4b, 4c). In addition, the church may be required to hire two (2) full time staff members at an average pay of \$8.00 to \$10 an hour for six (6) to eight (8) hours and train them to review the recording and produce a program transcript, segment the transcript into individual captions, with correct timing and positioning, review the end result for quality and accuracy as well as encode the result into the final media. Without proper training, there is always the possibility of experiencing a loss in quality which would not serve the masses well.

Financial Burden Closed Captioning will have on the Church: The economic impact of providing closed captioning services would be colossal and economically burdensome to the overall mission of the church. As previously stated, Unionville

Missionary Baptist Church is a non-profit organization. The work of the church is financed through charitable contributions that are received in large part from our parishioners. Charitable contributions are variable and in the year 2011, contributions decreased due to the economic hardships experienced by our parishioners. As of November 2011, the unemployment rate for the State of Georgia was 9.3% and in Middle Georgia it was 9.0 %. In the City of Macon, where the majority of our parishioners reside, the unemployment rate for November 2011 was 9.4 % which is only one 1% less than it was in November 2010 (Exhibit 5). There has been an inflation in the price of groceries, gas, healthcare insurances costs, etc. leading to an increase in the cost of living yet many parishioners have not had a cost of living or performance increase in their rate of pay for over 4 + years. In 2011, it cost the church \$ 48,925.22 to produce and distribute church media. Adding closed captioning would almost triple the cost to distribute the same media.


Financial Report: Due to our present financial obligations, Unionville Missionary Baptist Church is not in a financial position to provide closed captioning in-house or via our local station and continue to provide our church programming to the masses. As is evidenced by the attached Summary of Income and Expenditures for the year 2011, the church experienced a budget shortfall of \$ 50,649.57 (Exhibit 6). As a result, the church is not able to absorb the burden of offering closed captioning for our broadcast. At present, the church is attempting to reduce expenses and generate a budget which will ensure that the church will become financially secure in the year 2012.
