**Request: Investigation & Injunction Sanctioning AT&T for Threats over Merger Denial**

AT&T Inc. and its CEO Randall Stephenson are really mad at regulators for stopping Ma Bell from erecting Ma Cell on all of us. So mad that they are threatening to further mistreat customers with potentially more data caps, higher prices and by limiting speeds for what they refer to as heavy bandwidth users. I have already filed a complaint against AT&T to the AT&T – Mobil merger docket (11-65) and the docket concerning the AWS 700 MHZ unused Qualcomm wireless spectrum transaction with AT&T (11-18) that unlike the merger was approved to seek reparations from AT&T for its customers and an injunction barring them from further mistreating their users. I now submit this request along with the complaint to seek an order preventing AT&T from implementing any of the threatened data caps or higher prices they intend to impose on their customers because the merger failed. Had this disastrous merger gone through everyone could have faced higher prices on their wireless phone bills not just AT&T customers as a low-cost competitor that innovated using cheaper pricing as its advantage would have been removed from the market post-merger. T-Mobil USA customers not wanting to become AT&T customers joined with public interest advocates and other concerned citizens and activists to petition against the merger. I also request a speedy approval process of the wireless spectrum transaction of AT&T licenses being transferred to T-Mobile USA. This transaction is not anti-competitive as the AT&T merger would have been and the spectrum going to T-Mobile will help it remain in the market as a viable competitor. T-Mobile which has come out of this as a weaker player could gain strength with this spectrum and the cash infusion AT&T is putting into it as part of their breakup agreement.

If I believe its necessary I will file a separate request asking for the AT&T spectrum being transferred to T-Mobile to be allowed to occur as quickly as possible. Thank you FCC for stopping the AT&T T-Mobile merger. Please act upon my complaint and request(s) asap.
