Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 31, 2012, Sasha Field, Senior Vice President, TerreStar Networks, David LaFrance, Director, TerreStar Networks, together with Jeffrey Blum, Senior Vice President and Deputy General Counsel, DISH Network Corporation ("DISH"), and Alison Minea, Corporate Counsel, DISH, spoke by telephone with Gardner Foster, Assistant Chief, International Bureau, Robert Nelson, Chief, Satellite Division, and Karl Kensinger, Deputy Chief, Satellite Division, with regard to the Ancillary Terrestrial Component ("ATC") technical waivers associated with the applications and request for waivers in these proceedings. The parties inquired whether there were outstanding questions or issues regarding the ATC technical waivers. The parties also reported on the status of discussions regarding the requested waiver of Section 25.252(a)(1). In addition, TerreStar confirmed its continued expectation, pursuant to the existing TerreStar Network Security Agreement ("Agreement"),¹ that the Commission adopt a "Condition to FCC Authorization," in conjunction with approval of the pending applications, which would make FCC approval of the transaction conditioned upon compliance with the Agreement.
