Mark,

Please find the attached Item 21 for the FRN in question (2042868) for Greenburgh Graham.

Basically - the FY 2010 application went through PIA - we submitted Item 21s - then submitted supporting documentation - the SLD sent us the FCDL with the FRN approved (and modified to agree with applicant documentation - See attached)

Everything was fine until we attempted to file for a BEAR disbursement from CDWG - they claimed the FRN wasn't funded and the SLD overturned its original decision of funding this FRN - labeled it NOT funded stating that "Certain Items were not listed on the Item 21s".

All Item WERE listed on the Item 21s - the Supporting contract was even submitted to verify that - and the FRN was funded. We are at a loss as to why this decision was overturned and request that the status of the FRN be returned to FUNDED so the school district can get the money they are owed from CDWG.
