Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Friday, February 3, 2012, Ed Hollingsworth of PTC-220, LLC ("PTC-220") and Michele Farquhar, counsel to PTC-220, met with John Leibovitz, Roger Noel, Lloyd Coward, Richard Arsenault, Rodney Conway, and Erin Griffith of the FCC's Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. Jim Barrett, Bart Downing, and Steve Huff, each of PTC-220, participated in the meeting via telephone.

As reflected in the accompanying presentation, which was provided to the Commission staff at the meeting, the parties discussed PTC-220's need for waiver relief from the power and antenna height limitations set forth in Section 90.729 of the Commission's rules, which are applicable to PTC-220's licenses in the 220 MHz band that PTC-220 intends to use in the deployment of a nationwide, interoperable network for positive train control. The representatives from PTC-220 discussed how a waiver would enable PTC-220 to more efficiently use the spectrum located in the upper portion of the 220 MHz band, and the measures that PTC-220 and its members could undertake to mitigate any potential interference to co-channel licensees in adjacent markets and adjacent channel licensees.
