**ORDER**

**Issued: February 7, 2012**

This is an *interim* ruling on situational circumstances described in Maritime's Status Report on Discovery and Request for Partial Extension of Time ("Status Motion"), filed on February 6, 2012.<sup>1</sup>

Without analyzing fault or responsibility for an admitted inability of Maritime to timely and substantially comply with the discovery mandated in *Order FCC 12M-7*, the following *interim* procedures ARE SET to assist the parties in their efforts.

<sup>1</sup> There has been no Opposition or other responsive pleading filed by any party as of issuance of this *Order*, that has come to the attention of OALJ.

I.

By close of business **February 8, 2012**, Maritime's counsel will provide sufficiently identified and numbered copies of all documents contained in "box of documents" (with none removed) that have been in possession of Maritime's counsel at all relevant times.

II.


By dates and means proposed by Maritime in its Status Motion, the following recommended timelines and procedures ARE SET:

1. By Noon on **February 8, 2012**, first lot of approximately one half the universe of documents will be made available to Bureau counsel for in-house inspection and copying.
2. Balance of documents will be made available to Bureau counsel by close of business on **February 13, 2012**.
3. On completion of the electronic reproduction process of documents as scanned by Maritime's printer (*no later than Friday February 17, 2012*) a full and complete set of scanned documents will be made available to SkyTel at one-half of the cost to Maritime charged by the printer;
4. Alternatively, if SkyTel so elects, the original documents (after their return by the Bureau) will be made available to SkyTel for inspection and copying at an agreed time and location within the confines of the City of Washington, District of Columbia.

Finally, all parties seeking discovery of Maritime's documents (as described in Status Motion) SHALL AFFIRMATIVELY COOPERATE to carry out all steps necessary to meet the timelines specified above, while protecting the integrity of the documents.<sup>2</sup>

SO ORDERED.<sup>3</sup>

<sup>2</sup> There is no definitive process presented for document numbering. The universe of the document accounting and production begins with Maritime. Therefore, Maritime must utilize a numbering system which at all times accounts for each document. The Bureau, and possibly SkyTel, may adopt for their own purposes, separate numbering system(s).
