

As a licensed land surveyor (IA #14810), I depend on GPS for my business, as a State Legislator, I depend on GPS to locate various meeting sites, constituents homes, and positioning via my cell phone.

Without the proper functioning of the current GPS my concern is for my livelihood, my ability to locate and map directions for meetings, and for emergency personnel to locate me should it become necessary.

I understand the value of an expanded network but not at the expense of a system already in place. As you know, all of the engineering studies conducted, including those recently released by the government agency in charge of federal radio spectrum management, clearly show that LightSquared's proposed network causes interference and that there are no remedies to fix this interference.

I believe the FCC should formally adopt its proposed recommendations and deny LightSquared the authority to offer any ground-based wireless network.
