Dear Ms. Dortch:

Yesterday, Verizon filed a Reply to oppositions to Verizon's above-captioned Petition for Clarification or, in the Alternative, for Reconsideration. Page 2 of Verizon's Reply contained a typographical error with respect to Verizon Wireless' remaining competitive ETC funding, referencing 2013 instead of 2012 in the fourth sentence of the first full paragraph on that page. The affected sentence should correctly read as follows:

Which of these two alternatives was intended by the Commission in the new order is not clear, but the order could be construed to mean that Verizon and Sprint CETC support (in non-controlled markets) ceases at the end of 2012.
