

I agree with the FCC's recommendation to withdraw the LightSquared approval. Although bandwidth demand appears to be expanding, and additional wireless service may be needed, this should not come at the expense of the existing GPS network. A majority of the evidence seems to indicate that LightSquared's transmitters are disruptive to existing GPS receivers. Due to the large amount of GPS receivers already in service and the importance of the receivers when compared to the importance of immediately rolling out new wireless service, it seems that denying LightSquared's approval is the best course of action.
