If the GPS signal is not reliable I will no longer be able to take friends and family sailing in the bay. Wireless broadband service is important, but it should not come at the expense of GPS.

All the studies show that LightSquared's proposed network would cause interference and I understand that there are no remedies.

I am relying on you to protect the integrity of the GPS signal and I support your recommendation to stop LightSquared's current proposal.
