

I rely on using my GPS systems to safely navigate the Puget Sound while fishing and cursing. I use a Chartplotter with GPS, an iPhone with GPS and a AIS system to locate and identify possible ships in the area. Both are critical to safe boating.

If my GPS is disabled by interference, this would essentially shut down my ability to safely cruise the Puget Sound.

I recognize the importance of Wireless broadband service. However, it cannot come at the expense of accurate and reliable GPS.

All the studies show that LightSquared's proposed network would cause interference and that there are no remedies.
