

Please accept this communication as my adamant opposition to any approval of any wireless broadband service which could remotely have the effect of disturbing the current GPS system(s).

I rely on GPS as an offshore boater and there have been many instances whereby my reliance on GPS has allowed me to return to my home port safely, when there were no other safeguards available. Without the access to GPS there is no doubt in my mind that I would possibly have been unable to return to shore safely.

I realize that broadband service is necessary but, in no instance, should it interfere with GPS service, either in the near or long term. To approve this service even if there is the most remote possibility of GPS interference, would be an unthinkable travesty. As I understand everything I have read or heard, there is no remedy for interference that would be caused by approval of this request.

In closing, I support the FCC's recommendation to block the pending (and any future) proposal.
