I am a regular user of GPS. In my car, it is incredibly useful on a daily basis for an accurate position map, location of needed services, and of course accurate directions turn by turn and with a full map. It also is useful to integrate with my weather alerts through Sirius radio.

I also depend on it on my sailboat on the Potomac River and middle Chesapeake Bay for accurate positioning to avoid running aground and location during storms, as well as my auto-pilot system. Any interference with the signal will be a serious problem and indeed, a very dangerous situation.

I also know that the barge and freighters I have to avoid are dependat onthe same system. Some of those running aground would result in serious environmental spill impacts. Lack of a reliable signal also threatens life threatening collisions.

Please conclude the withdrawal of approval. The system is just too important to too many people to let one company interfere with it for their own profit.
