

Up here in AK there are limited navigational aides and help is often hours away or simply unavailable. To us GPS is not just a primary means of navigation, it is often our only means of communicating distress (via PLB's.) Wireless broadband service is important, but it should not come at the expense of GPS.

All the studies show that LightSquares proposed network would cause interference and that there are no remedies.

We rely on the FCC to protect the integrity of the GPS signal and I support your recommendation to stop LightSquares current proposal
