

I humbly request the FCC despite NAB objections to require this shift to online disclosure as a way to increase transparency. Broadcasters have had their political and public files at their offices for years and no one in the general public could find out what's in a particular broadcaster's files without asking to see them. They would share only with the individual making the request and it is inconvenient to do so because you can't submit request in writing, or over the phone but would have to go to their station and ask to see the file, which is often hidden in a drawer. They have buried the file in a drawer to make it harder for the public to see. They seem to have forgotten about their public interest obligations.
