

I am a private boat owner in NJ and primarily navigate in the Barnegat Bay. The bay at lower tides has many areas where a boat can very suddenly find itself in water with insufficient draft. The use of a GPS is an essential tool for keeping a boat undamaged and the crew and passengers safe. Recent studies show that the proposed LightSquared network would cause interference with the GPS signal and that there are no remedies to avoid this. A reliable uninterrupted GPS system is a vital aid to the boating community. I support the recommendation to stop LightSquared's current proposal.
