Dear Ms. Dortch:

This is to advise that on February 1, 2012, the undersigned, together with Jose M. Martin, Executive Vice President & Chief Operating Officer, PowerTrunk, Inc., met with Michael Wilhelm, Deputy Chief, Policy Division, Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau, Roberto Mussenden and Brian Marengo, in connection with the above referenced proceedings.¹

PowerTrunk's representatives explained that the purpose of the meeting was to gain a better understanding of Commission Rules 90.547 and 90.548. We addressed the use of gateways for 700 MHz interoperability, and potential implementation challenges. In particular, we discussed scenarios in which gateways might not be available to provide interoperability.

Apart from whether gateways are suitable for interoperability under Rules 90.547 and 90.548, we referenced PowerTrunk's compliance with the Rules based on a multimode solution for 700 MHz interoperability.

¹ This notice is being submitted beyond the two-day period contemplated by the Rules. We regret the inadvertence. Our discussion of gateways was in the context of current Rules 90.547 and 90.548. However, because gateways are a subject of the rulemaking in the above referenced dockets, we are making this filing out of an abundance of caution.
