

I use GPS to navigate my sailboat in the Chesapeake Bay. Without it, sailing would be much less safe, particularly over longer distances and in less favorable or unexpected conditions. If GPS became unavailable, or worse became unreliable, we would still sail, but it would be a less safe and less enjoyable activity. Wireless broadband service is important, but it should not come at the expense of GPS. All the studies show that LightSquared's proposed network would cause interference and that there are no remedies. I rely on the FCC to protect the integrity of the GPS signal and support its recommendation to stop LightSquared's current proposal.
