

I would like to express my concern about the lighthsquare project interference with GPS signals.

In my daily life, I use GPS to find addresses and driving routes. I am also an avid boater and I depend on GPS for safe navigation especially in congested areas where traditional plotting methods would entail risk and delays in order to achieve safe navigation.

If the GPS signal would no longer be reliable the navigation on land or water would become more time consuming and even fraught with risk.

The broadband service proposed is useful but should be assigned to other frequencies that do not involve risk of interference and proper and thorough research should be done before implementing the service.

I rely on the FCC to protect me from interference on any of the services that use communications and that any new service should not come at the expense of previously approved and in use systems.
