

As the Petition filed by LPS indicates our office represents the District. After our phone conversation on February 23, 2012 I contacted the District to obtain information concerning your two inquiries:

1. Does the District keep a log or other documentation of all harassing or threatening calls received? The answer is no they have not kept such a separate log or documentation in the past.
2. If the waiver were to be granted would the equipment used by the District serve only the District or would other persons/entities have use or access to the "private" numbers? The District response to me was : The equipment mentioned would only support calls coming into Liberty Schools and would not be accessible or useable by any other entity or business. It would be solely for the use of Liberty Public Schools. Basically it is a device that sits between the phone company and our communications system that records all phone numbers coming in. If someone were calling a school building with a private number it would still show up as private at the school when the call was answered. However, if it were a bomb threat we could then easily go to the device and pull the actual phone number that made the call.

If you have further questions or need additional information please contact me and I will do my best. I am hopeful that the review of the District's waiver application, filed April 22, 2007, can be completed in the near future. Many thanks, Tom.
