Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 8, 2012, Steve Edwards, Scott Deutchman, William Reidway, Aaron Goldberger, and Lavinia Rotaru of Neustar, Inc., and I met with Sharon Gillett, Travis Litman, Ann Stevens, Sanford Williams, Marilyn Jones, and Kimberly Jackson of the Commission. Our discussions covered the matters reflected in the attached presentation.

Neustar also noted that the need for telephone numbers is expected to continue to rise as networks convert to all-IP infrastructure. According to Gartner, Inc., media tablet sales are expected to surpass 208M units in 2014 (<http://www.gartner.com/it/page.jsp?id=1452614>); a significant portion of which will include wireless connectivity. Neustar expects that this trend, in combination with those related to the growth of mobile WiFi and SIM-based machine-to-machine devices, will continue to sustain the demand for numbering resources, alongside the demand driven by traditional voice and messaging services

In addition, we briefly discussed the LNPA RFP process. We stated that Neustar supports the consensus process and would like to see it go forward without delay. We explained that Commission and NANC oversight of NAPM's selection process should reflect the competitiveness of the marketplace and an appreciation of the industry's experience and technical expertise, consistent with past Commission practice. We emphasized the importance of the Commission's existing neutrality requirements. We also referred to economic studies
