Re: Notice of Ex Parte Communication, Applications of Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless, SpectrumCo LLC and Cox TMI Wireless, LLC for Consent To Assign Licenses Held by SpectrumCo LLC and by Cox TMI Wireless, LLC (WT Docket No. 12-4)

Dear Ms. Dortch:

This will report on a communication that occurred on March 8, 2012, in which Mr. John T. Komiji, Senior Vice President and General Counsel of Hawaiian Telcom Communications, Inc. (“Hawaiian Telcom”), Andrew D. Lipman of Bingham McCutchen, LLP, and the undersigned met with Marius Schwartz, Eric Ralph, William “Bill” Dever, Paul Murray, Ziad Sleem, Susan Singer, Jim Bird and Joel Rabinovitz of the FCC to discuss the above-captioned docket.

Mr. Lipman began by introducing Mr. Komiji and Hawaiian Telcom and identifying the carrier's interest in this proceeding. The presentation relating to the Verizon-SpectrumCo transaction and joint marketing agreements was given by Mr. Komiji, with some commentary by the undersigned. The Hawaiian Telcom representatives reiterated points raised in Hawaiian Telcom’s February 21, 2012 Petition to Deny or Condition Assignment of Licenses. In addition, the Hawaiian Telcom representatives discussed Hawaiian Telcom’s interest in maintaining a level playing field for the sale of wireless backhaul to Verizon Wireless, especially in light of the increased need that Verizon Wireless will have for backhaul in light of its acquisition of spectrum if the license transfer is approved and in avoiding an extension of the exclusivity that Oceanic Time Warner Cable has in Hawaii over certain programming to Verizon Wireless. The Hawaiian Telcom representatives also discussed the below cost pricing tactics that Oceanic Time Warner had been using to exclude nascent competition from Hawaiian Telcom in the video market in Hawaii and expressed concern that Oceanic Time Warner Cable would be able to further entrench its uniquely high monopoly share of the video market in Hawaii through the proposed transactions
