As an Amateur Radio Operator I strongly and unequivocally support this petition. I also agree that it is long past the time where PRB-1 needs to be reexamined and reevaluated, in light of continued efforts by HOAs to unlawfully interfere with and restrict the lawful operation of federally licensed amateur radio stations. The Commission, as mandated by federal law and regulation, does indeed have the power, and the obligation, to end the unfair and discriminatory actions of HOAs against amateur operators, and to ease or lift the burden of unfair CC&R restrictions against said operators. The Commission has acted in the past to nullify such restrictions and burdens with regard to commercial radio and television services, and that is well and good, but amateur stations and operators, who are equally subject to Commission rule as are the commercial operators, should enjoy the same protections afforded to other federally licensed services.
