**PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION**

Marana Unified School District (the “District”) through counsel undersigned and pursuant to Section 1.106 of the Federal Communications Commission’s (“FCC” or “Commission”) rules,<sup>1</sup> hereby petitions the Telecommunications Access Policy Division (“Division”) of the Commission’s Wireline Competition Bureau for reconsideration of the above-captioned Order.<sup>2</sup> This Petition is filed in conjunction with the Petition for Reconsideration (“Trillion’s Petition”) filed by Trillion Partners, Inc. (“Trillion”) for reconsideration of the above-Captioned Order. Trillion has set forth in great detail the procedural and factual history of this matter in its Petition. The District will not restate

that history here and instead incorporates Trillion's Petition by reference as if fully set forth herein.

As noted in Trillion's Petition, the District previously filed appeals of USAC's denial of the District's applications for funding years 2009 and 2010, and demand payment letter for funding year 2008. These appeals included copies of a letter dated June 22, 2010 to Pina Portanova of the USAC's Schools and Libraries Division, in which the District provided detailed information on the RFP and competitive bidding process that resulted in the award of a contract to Trillion. The previous appeals, and the June 22, 2010 letter are attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference.

The competitive bidding process that resulted in the award of a contract to Trillion for WAN services for funding years 2006 – 2010 was conducted in a fair and open manner and was not tainted in any way. The documents previously provided to USAC demonstrate that Trillion was, by a wide margin, the lowest responsive bidder. Trillion provided services to the District throughout the term of the contract. The loss of funding for any of these years will be devastating to the District and to Trillion.

For all of the reasons set forth in Trillion's Petition and the previous appeals filed in this matter, the District respectfully requests reconsideration of the Division's *Order* and the granting of the relief requested herein.
