Dear Ms. Dortch:

This notice is provided pursuant to directives of the Federal Communications Commission in its *Third Report and Order*, 23 FCC Rcd. 12561 (2008), and Section 10.230 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 10.230, by Commercial Mobile Service provider, Airadigm Communications, Inc. d/b/a AirFire Mobile ("Airadigm").

Airadigm hereby submits a change of election from that filed September 4, 2008, wherein the company chose to participate in Commercial Mobile Alert System (CMAS) by transmitting emergency messages "in part." Airadigm hereby submits its election to participate in CMAS "in whole," and states as follows:

1. Airadigm elects to transmit CMAS emergency alerts.
2. Airadigm agrees to transmit such alerts in a manner consistent with the technical standards, protocols, procedures and other technical requirements implemented by the Commission.
3. Airadigm commits to support the development and deployment of technology for the "C" interface, the CMS provider Gateway, the CMS provider infrastructure, and mobile devices with CMAS functionality and support of the CMS provider selected technology.

Should the Commission require further information from Airadigm, it will be provided.
