

Due to the proceedings regarding interoperability of channel 51 with the lower 700 MHz band and the proceeding regarding reallocating the remaining UHF TV band to wireless use, One Ministries, Inc. respectfully requests the FCC extend the construction deadline to build any outstanding LPTV construction permits. One Ministries, Inc. filed for digital LPTV construction permits and is worried that any construction we may do on channel 51 or any part of the TV band may end up being a waste of funds due to needing to change channels in the future. The FCC has tolled the construction period for broadcast permits when those permits are held up by local government bodies. This case is similar. We request that the this time where these proceedings are going on should be tolled and added to the construction period for outstanding LPTV construction permits. Otherwise, it is unfair to put the construction of new LPTV permits at financial risk in the event the Commission changes allocations and rules for the UHF TV band. Ideally, it would be helpful if the Commission extended the construction deadline for existing digital LPTV permits until September 1, 2015, which is the expiration date the Commission previously extended all displacement LPTV permits to.
