REPLY COMMENTS ON PROPOSED LIST OF CENSUS BLOCKS ELIGIBLE
FOR BIDDING

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of WUE, Inc. (“WUE”), and pursuant to the Commission’s February 16, 2012 Public Notice (DA 12-236), we hereby submit these reply comments on the census blocks to be made eligible for bidding in the Mobility Fund Phase I Auction (Auction No. 901). In particular, WUE has challenged the eligibility for auction of the census blocks listed in Attachment A to its March 15, 2012 Comments in this proceeding (encompassing nearly all of Lincoln County, Nevada and small portions of neighboring counties). As demonstrated in its Comments, WUE had completed implementation of 3G coverage to many of the census blocks in Attachment A, and had already begun implementation of 3G service to the other census blocks, with implementation expected to be completed imminently. As detailed in the attached Declaration of WUE, Inc. President John W. Christian, six of WUE, Inc.’s remaining nine cell sites were built last week on schedule; a seventh site is being constructed today with a start up date of tomorrow; and the other two sites are under construction and are undergoing technical adjustments, to be

turned up once any technical issues are resolved. Thus, the “future coverage” referred to in the Engineering Statement and related exhibits attached to WUE, Inc.’s comments is now either implemented or being actively constructed at this time. Therefore, the Commission should remove the census blocks listed in Attachment A from the list of areas eligible for bidding in Auction No. 901.


