Dear Chairman Genachowski:

I write to you in support of Northern Virginia-based LightSquared. As a resident of partially-rural Loudoun County, Virginia, I believe our country's broadband infrastructure is insufficient to meet the ever-growing demand for iPhones, Blackberry's, tablets and other broadband devices. I hope that the Federal Communications Commission will support efforts to create more affordable broadband services.

LightSquared's 4G-LTE service should work to increase access to wireless broadband, which in turn will increase competition in the wireless marketplace and give consumers more choices.

With engineering and investment hurdles behind them, LightSquared is ready to launch its broadband network which should provide uninterrupted coverage in every corner of the country, which I know will be a benefit to rural areas of Virginia like western Loudoun County.
