
Dear Chairman Genachowski:

As Policy Advisor to both former Governor Haley Barbour and former Commissioner of Agriculture Lester Spell, I have had the opportunity to meet with representatives from numerous innovative, next-generation companies who had a product they wanted to bring to Mississippi. I am always impressed by companies who are willing to make significant private investments into their product, compared to those who bring a concept to the table and then proceed to ask for government funds to implement the idea.

I understand that LightSquared has already invested \$4 billion of private funds into the development of their integrated satellite/broadband technology which brings with it a broad scope of other benefits: increased competition, improved access in rural areas (which will specifically impact over half a million Mississippians), and lower prices just to name a few.

Furthermore, I understand LightSquared has demonstrated a willingness to do everything in their capacity to resolve any concerns raised by the FCC, the GPS industry, or anyone else involved.
