On March 30, 2012 Richard Harvey, Andy Lachance, and Tamara Preiss of Verizon; Sean Haynberg, consultant to Verizon; Joe Banos, Patrick Cook, Alan Van Buren, and Chris Ashworth of Wilson Electronics; and Russell Lukas, counsel to Wilson, met with the following Commission staff regarding the above-captioned proceeding: John Leibovitz, Roger Noel, Tom Derenge, Moslem Sawez, and Becky Schwartz of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau; and Bruce Romano, Ira Keltz, and Rashmi Doshi of the Office of Engineering & Technology. (Ms. Schwartz and Messrs. Derenge, Keltz, Doshi, Cook, Van Buren, and Ashworth participated by telephone.)

During the meeting, Wilson and Verizon discussed and explained the draft consumer booster rules that the companies jointly filed in this docket on March 14, 2012, focusing on changes to the Verizon/Wilson Joint Proposal made to simplify the specifications, to accommodate requests from third parties, and to address licensing issues.¹ In addition, Wilson and Verizon discussed the progress of discussions with other carriers and booster manufacturers and urged the FCC to move quickly to adopt the draft rules.
