Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 22, 2012, Comcast Corporation filed its response to the Commission's Information and Discovery Request in this proceeding.¹ Because of an inadvertent error in the electronic Summation production included with Comcast's response, Comcast is submitting under separate cover a revised version of the hard drive containing the electronic files.

The revised submission contains Confidential and Highly Confidential Information and is being submitted pursuant to the Protective Order and Second Protective Order in this proceeding.² Comcast is contemporaneously providing the revised version of the electronic submission to Protective Order signatories that received the prior version earlier this week and is asking those parties to either return the copy they previously received or certify that they have destroyed it.³ Copies of each version of this filing are being provided to the Secretary's Office
