Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 22, 2012, Comcast Corporation filed its response to the Commission's Information and Discovery Request in this proceeding.¹ In the cover letter accompanying its response, Comcast noted that, pursuant to discussions with Commission staff, it had limited the production of materials in response to certain requests pending further instructions from the Commission staff.² In response to a Commission staff request, Comcast is submitting a supplemental production under separate cover.
