

Blocking wireless services in the manner BART did is wrong. So is Internet censorship SOPA/PIPA style. Despite the defeat of the Stop Online Piracy Act and Protect IP Act earlier this year in Congress following huge protests by tech companies and individual citizens Congress nor the MPAA have learned the meaning of no. Nor has President Obama unfortunately who despite vowing to veto such legislation if it threatened Internet freedom still wants similar legislation to pass into law.
