Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 13, 2012, Richard Harvey and Andy Lachance of Verizon, and Sean Haynberg, consultant to Verizon, met by teleconference with the following Commission staff regarding the above-captioned proceeding: Joyce Jones, Moslem Sawez, and Becky Schwartz of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau; and Bruce Romano, Ira Keltz, and Rashmi Doshi of the Office of Engineering & Technology.

During the meeting, Verizon discussed the draft consumer booster rules filed jointly in this docket by Verizon and Wilson Electronics on March 14, 2012.¹ Verizon answered questions from FCC staff about the consumer booster specifications set forth in the draft rules and how each would operate to protect wireless networks from harmful interference. Verizon also discussed how the FCC could create device certification standards and test procedures to ensure that signal boosters meet the specifications. In addition, Verizon discussed the progress of discussions with other carriers.
