
Compliance would impose an "undue economic burden," as defined in section 79.1 (f) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. 79.1 (f).1

This show and its producers do not have the funds or resources to provide closed captioning. There is no way to afford the cost of closed captioning and our delivery system is done through a digital cloud from all over the state making it impossible to bring the content together. Options have been explored to pay or receive sponsorship to have KCSG provide closed captioning, but they have informed us that they don't have the resources or money either and don't have the employee man power required to fulfill this request either.

We are willing to take the necessary steps in order to comply with all regulations. Please let us know if there is any further action we can or need to take.
