On land GPS has become an important tool for my husband's business, however as fairly new boaters on Lake Ontario our GPS is critical. Not only for spending our vacation time and money to vacation along the NY coast of Lake Ontario, but even for day trips if we need to seek the closest safe harbor once we're boating away from home port or locate the closest marine fuel pump. If the LightSquared network interferes with GPS navigation or the accuracy of GPS, many boaters will not feel safe to travel and visit the many visitor's areas from Buffalo to the Thousand Islands. Our GPS also discloses the Shipping lanes and Military area of the lake, where we would want to be especially careful.
