On April 18, 2012, Michael Maddix of Sorenson Communications, Inc. (“Sorenson”), together with the undersigned, attended the iTRS Advisory Council meeting in Crystal City, Virginia. Three members of the FCC staff were in attendance as well: Greg Hlibok (Chief, Disability Rights Office, Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau), Robert Aldrich (Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau), and Diane Mason (Office of the Managing Director).

At the meeting, Mr. Maddix urged the Commission staff in attendance to take action on a Petition for Limited Reconsideration filed by Hamilton Relay in the above-captioned docket on June 1, 2011. In its petition, Hamilton requested that the Commission direct the TRS Fund Administrator to make interest payments on withheld reimbursements where the TRS Fund Administrator or the Commission ultimately determines the minutes at issue are compensable. Mr. Maddix noted that Sorenson filed in support of Hamilton’s petition on June 9, 2011. Later in the meeting the iTRS Advisory Council resolved to submit a letter to the Commission and the TRS Fund Administrator urging adoption of Hamilton’s proposal.
