

In regard to service rules for AWS spectrum holders I urge the FCC to implement interoperability requirements in the AWS spectrum bands especially if Verizon Wireless wins regulatory approval for the SpectrumCo and Cox licensing deals which I oppose not just because of the spectrum concentration but potential for collusion with the marketing agreements (12-4). Also I urge the FCC to not let Verizon's proposed sale of 700 MHz spectrum to smaller carriers to save its deals with big cable TV companies for spectrum endanger 700 MHz interoperability. The FCC must rule in the affirmative with an order mandating 700 MHz interoperability as I have stated in that proceeding before. The FCC should also propose interoperability as one of the service rules on AWS spectrum holders. Also attach build-out requirements on AWS and 700 MHz spectrum ensuring large carriers can't just warehouse spectrum to deprive smaller carriers of getting access to it. Spectrum is the lifeblood of wireless communications and smaller competitors need more of it than bigger companies to stay competitive. AT&T and Verizon have enough already.
