On September 7, 2011, the Media Bureau's above-referenced *Memorandum Opinion and Order* granted TiVo Inc. ("TiVo") a waiver of Sections 15.118(b), 15.123(b)(1), and 15.123(c) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 15.118(b), 15.123(b)(1), and 15.123(c), for TiVo's *Premiere Elite* line of digital video recorders. TiVo is submitting this letter to notify the Commission that TiVo has changed the name of the *Premiere Elite* to the *Premiere XL4*. The new *XL4* name will henceforth appear on the front of the devices, on the cartons, and in all documentation and marketing materials. In every respect other than name, the *Premiere XL4* is identical to the *Premiere Elite*. Therefore, all the conditions specified in the *Memorandum Opinion and Order* as applicable to the *Premiere Elite* remain applicable to the *Premiere XL4*.
