

The FCC, which has so far failed to apply Network Neutrality rules of nondiscrimination to wireless carriers, should require any wireless carriers acquiring new spectrum in upcoming incentive auctions comply with this common carrier rule of nondiscrimination. Furthermore the FCC should treat mobile broadband and broadband services like dial-up that is by reclassifying broadband as an advanced telecommunications service under Title II of the Telecommunications Act and deny Verizon SpectrumCo applications. Finally in holding the incentive auctions they should consider not all broadcast TV stations and cable networks are hoarding spectrum. Some wireless spectrum is used for mobile digital television services. Finally strong 700 MHz interoperability rules and strong AWS rules should be implemented.
