Re: Complaint of Sky Angel U.S., LLC Against Discovery Communications, LLC, *et al.*
For Violation of the Commission's Competitive Access to Cable Programming Rules

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On May 21, 2010, Sky Angel U.S., LLC ("Sky Angel") filed Responses and Objections to the First Set of Document Requests and First Set of Interrogatories propounded upon Sky Angel in the above-captioned proceeding by Discovery Communications, LLC ("Discovery") on April 21, 2010. On June 1, 2010, Discovery filed a letter with the Commission contending that Sky Angel was late in responding to the discovery requests propounded upon it by Discovery.

In making this contention, however, Discovery fails to note that, in its Document Requests propounded upon Sky Angel on April 21, 2010, it expressly requested that Sky Angel respond "within thirty (30) days from the date of this request." Accordingly, Sky Angel's May 21, 2010 Responses and Objections to the Document Requests were timely submitted to Discovery.

In addition, Discovery failed to note that, in its Interrogatories propounded upon Sky Angel on April 21, 2010, it expressly "request[ed] that the Commission order Sky Angel" to answer those Interrogatories "within thirty (30) days of the Commission's order." The Commission has not ordered Sky Angel to answer Discovery's Interrogatories. Accordingly, no deadline has ever been established for Sky Angel's response to those Interrogatories. Nevertheless, in the interest of addressing Discovery's various requests, Sky Angel also filed its Responses and Objections to the Interrogatories on May 21, 2010.
