

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On April 26, 2012 Bob Boaldin, President, Dian Boaldin, Vice President, Micheal Shannon, Assistant Manager, and Linda Ward, Marketing Director of Epic Touch (d/b/a Elkhart Telephone Company, Inc.) met with Carol Matthey, Patrick Halley, Amy Bender, Gary Seigel, and Katie King of the Wireline Competition Bureau. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the concerns of Epic Touch regarding reductions of universal support that the company is facing as a result of the Commission's *USF/ICC Transformation Order*. In particular, company representatives expressed concerns about the use of regression analysis to limit reimbursable capital and operating expenses for the purposes of determining High-Cost Loop Support (HCLS) for rate-of-return carriers and the potential application of that analysis to Interstate Common Line Support (ICLS).
