

Dear FCC,

San Tan Educational Media is an Arizona Non-Profit Organization that was formed with the specific goal of starting a LPFM Radio Station in our Community of San Tan Valley, Arizona. We have been around for many years and "Officially" organized for almost 2 years. In the Zip Code 85143 Second Channel Waivers would be needed in order for us to serve San Tan Valley, AZ. With Second Channel Waivers available on original CP's we have 3 Channels that make great candidates. Without second channel waivers we have NO Channels Available. We urge the commission to allow 2nd channel waivers. San Tan Educational Media also asks the Commission to Keep the Current 2 years for a Non-Profit to have officially existed and we strongly support the non-profit organization stays local during the duration of the license holding. San Tan Educational Media also strongly supports LPFM Station must provide LOCAL programming at least 8 hours a day. Without this requirement LPFM Station run the risk of being Satellite Fed Translators. San Tan Educational Media supports LPFM license holders having no more than 1 translator provided that translator is used to retransmit the on air signal of the LPFM that is held by that organization.

San Tan Educational Media also supports 250 watt LPFM Stations regardless of location and feel the requirement that only currently licensed LPFM license holders can apply for such power levels is not justified.

San Tan Educational Media also supports removing LP-10 stations in favor of REC's Proposal of a LP-50 Station Class or the LP-Flex model proposed by REC.

This filing window that is up and coming is an exciting opportunity for not only us, but many Organizations that have been waiting years for this chance. We hope the FCC will maximize this opportunity and will open the LPFM Filing window before the Presidential Election in 2012.
